

Covenant Blessing Worldview Academy Rules of Conduct & Covenant

The following guidelines are designed to ensure the **safety** and **security** of each child participating in the Covenant Blessing Worldview Academy (CBWA) as well as to create a **positive** environment for learning and building friendships. Willful or multiple instances of guideline violation can result in expulsion from the program.

Please read these guidelines and review them with your child.

General Club Guidelines

1. It is the discretion of CBWA leadership to, at any time, deny any family or individual the privilege of participation in the program. Any such denial will be explained in writing by the CBWA program director.
2. All submitted funds are to be considered non-refundable and only in rare cases will funds be returned purely at the discretion of CBWA leadership. Expulsion from the program does not entitle families to a refund of deposits.
3. As we strive to model consistency in our walk with our Savior Jesus Christ all participants are expected to attend meetings regularly. Execution of this goal is rewarded through the program.

Parent Requirements

1. Participation in the CBWA requires children to be accompanied to all sessions by a parent/guardian or a sponsoring adult. **No "drop-offs" will be allowed.** Any adult who is serving as the sponsor for the child is required to participate in the completion of outside assignments and tasks. Non-parent sponsoring adults are required to complete a non-parent agreement (which must also be signed by the child's parent) explaining the reason(s) the parents of the child are unable to participate.
2. Weekly sessions will begin promptly at **6:30 pm**. Parents shall make every attempt to be on time to meetings. During times when lateness is unavoidable, parents will contact the administrator who will subsequently inform the appropriate group leaders.
3. Parents are required to complete all directly assigned tasks, and to supervise the completion of at home devotional study and coursework assigned to their children by CBWA leadership.
4. CBWA leadership is required to be respectful to parents, children and volunteers. In return parents are asked to adhere to this same standard. This includes refraining from physical and verbal abuse, intimidation, or other non-constructive behavior or methods of communication.
5. Children are required to be respectful to all CBWA leaders, volunteers and parents and respectful of CBWA property.
6. Children are expected and encouraged to avoid ANY unkind speech and will refrain from ALL vulgarity, inappropriate gestures, and rough play.
7. No physical intimidation (including verbal threats) of other children will be tolerated.
8. No toys, digital music players, electronic games allowed – please leave these items at home. Bringing these will result in confiscation by CBWA leadership and will only be returned to the parent or sponsoring adult.
9. Cellular telephones can only be used to contact a parent in the case of an emergency.

COVENANT AGREEMENT

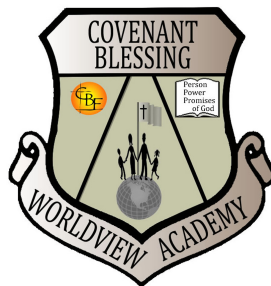
In response to, and support of, the goals and objectives set forth by the Covenant Blessing Worldview Academy please check the boxes below and provide the information, signature and date below.
